- STRING ORCHESTRA - String Orchestra (grades 4-12) meets ONLY on Fridays in Longmont. Students from ALL SITES may dual enroll in this class and participate.
- SECONDARY WORLD LANGUAGES - Middle and High School Spanish and French are offered in Longmont only. Students from ALL SITES may dual enroll in these classes. Please see the Longmont class grids for times.
- SAT/ACT PREP - This class is offered only in Longmont but is open to and strongly recommended for all 11th and 12th grade students at all sites.
- TRIG/PRE-CALC - This is a 2 session class. Students must dual enroll in both sessions to take this class.

DUAL ENROLLMENT FOR MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS:

- Students may dual enroll at more than one APEX site to avoid schedule conflicts in Math, Science, Language Arts, Social Studies and World Languages.
- Students must still maintain a full schedule (6 classes) at their primary site when dual enrolling.

CDC and CE:

- High School students participating in CDC and CE classes only need to enroll for 3 periods at their APEX site but may take more classes if they wish.
- Remaining periods may be study halls at the APEX site or students may leave campus with prior permission from their parents and the program director.
